Students will be sharing their web pages with other students during a walk through on Friday, October 17, 2003. Please come by.

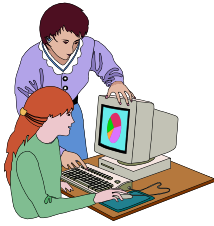
